BCDSCC IS SEEKING APPLICANTS TO SERVE ON THE BALTIMORE CITY BOARD OF ELECTIONS

The Baltimore City Democratic State Central Committee is seeking applicants to serve on the Baltimore City Board of Elections. The Baltimore City Democratic State Central Committee will vote to nominate four (4) individuals and such names will be forwarded to the Governor of Maryland who will select three (3) individuals to serve. All nominations made by the Baltimore City Democratic State Central Committee are subject to approval by the Governor and consent of the Maryland Senate.

The term of an election board member is 4 years and begins on the first Monday of June 2023. An election board member may not hold or be a candidate for public and/or political party office. In addition, an election board member is prohibited from taking an active part in political activity.

To be eligible for consideration, one must be:

- A registered Democratic voter in Baltimore City for 5 years immediately preceding the appointment.

To apply, interested applicants should send an email to baltimorecitydems@gmail.com by no later than **12:00 Noon on Thursday, January 26, 2023**. Please indicate “Board of Elections” in the email subject line and include the following:

3. Email address and phone number
4. A short bio of your background and why you wish to serve on the Board of Elections (5-6 sentences).

Emails received after the deadline will not be considered. Interviews of all eligible applicants will be held during a Special Meeting of the Baltimore City Democratic State Central Committee on **Thursday, January 26, 2023** via Zoom beginning at 7:00 p.m. The interviews are open to the public and will be live-streamed on the Baltimore City Democratic State Central Committee Facebook page (<https://www.facebook.com/baltimorecitydems>).

The elected voting members of the Baltimore City Democratic State Central Committee will vote publicly after the interviews to nominate four (4) individuals. Such individuals will be required to submit a resume and an online application to the Governor’s Appointments Office by January 31, 2023. Questions can be directed to baltimorecitydems@gmail.com.
