The Baltimore City Democratic State Central Committee is accepting resumes to fill a Central Committee Member vacancy in the **41st Legislative District**. Central Committee Members are elected through a process that recognizes three gender categories: female, male, and non-binary. There is **one (1) male vacancy** in the 41st Legislative District. **Non-binary applicants are also eligible to apply.**

### **Applicant Qualifications**

- Be a registered Democratic voter in the State of Maryland; and
- Be a resident of the 41st Legislative District.

### **Application Process**

Interested applicants should email a resume to [baltimorecitydems@gmail.com](mailto:baltimorecitydems@gmail.com) (**attached as a PDF**) and include **“District 41”** in the email subject line. Resumes must be received no later than **Monday, March 16, 2026 at 12:00 noon** to be considered. Late submissions will not be accepted. Resumes must include: Full legal name (no nicknames), full residential address, email address, and phone number.

### **Interviews**

Interviews for eligible candidates will be conducted **via Zoom on Tuesday, March 17, 2026**, starting at **6:00 PM**, by the seven (7) voting members of the 41st Legislative District. Applicants will be notified of their specific interview times after the resume submission deadline and prior to the interview date.

The interviews will be broadcast live on BCDSCC’s Facebook page, allowing the public to observe in real time. *A Facebook account is not required to view the live stream.*

Following the interviews, the seven (7) voting members of the 41<sup>st</sup> Legislative District will conduct a public vote. The selected individual will begin service immediately and will serve the remainder of the term, which concludes in November 2026.

### **Description of the Position**

This is a **volunteer position** that provides an opportunity to strengthen the Democratic Party in Baltimore City by increasing voter turnout and registering voters. Additionally, in the event of a vacancy in the Maryland House of Delegates or State Senate, the Central Committee member will vote to fill the vacancy. The selected individual is expected to: Attend monthly Baltimore City Central Committee meetings, Attend Maryland Democratic Party meetings, and Participate actively in Central Committee activities. Central Committee members serve the Maryland Democratic Party as **grassroots volunteers**.
